**Requirements for authors:**

- On line registration through the forum's web site (it is mandatory for the contact author to be registered).
- Each paper may have a maximum of three authors.
- Each author may submit up to three papers, both individually or collectively.
- At least one author's fee must be covered before August 17, 2018 for the paper to be scheduled.

**Submission of the research paper's abstract:**

The following must be sent electronically through the forum's web site:

- An abstract that includes: Title, main objective/objectives, methodology used, results obtained, reach and limitations of the results and conclusions derived from the analysis of results.
- Full version of the research paper must include title and abstract, 18-25 pages long. No mention of authorship should be made. In a separate document please include: title of the paper and authors information (name, institution, e-mail). Contact author should be stated.
- Due date for the submission of abstract and full version of the research paper: **Extended due date June 22, 2018.**
- Notification of acceptance/rejection from: July 23, 2018.

**Lecture requirements:**

- A 20 minutes PowerPoint presentation must be submitted.
- Due date for the submission of the presentation: August 24, 2018.

**Requirements for possible publication of research papers:**

- To be considered for publication, as part of a specialized collective book on risk management, the research paper must comply with the set of academic and editorial guidelines indicated in the forum's web site and the Grupo de Mercados e Instituciones Financieras web page <http://gimif.azc.uam.mx>. The research papers submitted must be original, unpublished and should not be undergoing any other publication procedure. All research papers will be double-blind peer-reviewed.
